


First Grade News



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Reading

This week in Readers
Workshop, first graders
practiced retelling fiction
stories. Readers can use
this retelling hand as a
tool. They were
encouraged to retell the
story using the words,
"First, Then, After..." When
retelling a story, students
also need to include the
character's names, story
problem and solution.



Finally, they are working on identifying character feelings as well as the lesson in the book.

Fundations


First graders continued Unit 4 of Fundations which focuses on bonus letters (ff, II, ss) and the glued sound /all/. We continued to



practice marking up the bonus letters with a star, and our glued sounds by boxing the letters. We also learned the trick words: I, they, was, one

Math

This week we concluded our unit on Addition and Subtraction word problems. Students write their own story problems based on equations. Students also learned a new game called Number Puzzles, where they had to use the digits 0-9 to complete number sentences.



Science

This week in science students continued to learn about the parts of a plant and the roles they play in understanding the life cycle. Then we made models to show the different parts of plants, including the stem, roots, and leaves out of different craft materials! We also observed that the grass seeds we planted and hung in our windows are growing!

Writing

In writing, first graders continued working on their small moment stories. We



studied mentor texts and the students attempted to add craft moves to their writing such as "pop out" words in bold and all caps, ellipses and writing with exact actions.
