Social Emotional Learning

This week we focused on the Mitchell School expectations of taking care of ourselves, taking care of others and taking care of our school. Students brainstormed important rules for our classroom and school that help us achieve these expectations. In our Second Step SEL curriculum, first graders also learned that our eyes, ears and brain help us to focus. We need to focus to learn. Teachers sent home information for this lesson so students can continue practicing these skills at home.



Reading

This week in reading, we continued to build good habits. Students learned to "do something" when they have finished a story. They can reread their favorite part, reread the whole book, think back over the parts, or retell it to themselves. Students are also reading more and more and keeping track of their reading. Readers have become so engaged and excited to partner read to practice all of these skills.



Social Studies

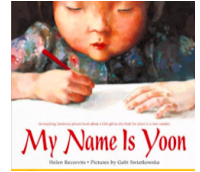
This week in Social Studies, first graders learned about the holiday of Rosh Hashanah. Students learned that Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year, and people often greet each other on this day by saying "L'shanah tovah" which means "for a good year". People may eat apples and bread dipped in honey to represent a sweet new year to come, and may worship at a synagogue. A shofar, an instrument made of a ram's horn, may also be blown.
